### Faithful to his Promises

*“Not one word failed of all his good promises he promised through Moses.” - 1 Kings 8:56*

- John 14:12 – He wants to do it
- Luke 12:32 – He loves to give
- Isaiah 30:18 – He loves to bless
- Luke 11:11 – He will not give a stone
- Hebrews 11:6 – He is expecting
- Ephesians 3:20 – He is willing
- 2 Chronicles 16:9 – He is waiting

### Faithful to his Promises

*“His divine power has given us everything we need for life and godliness through our knowledge of him who called us by his own glory and goodness. Through these he has given us his very great and precious promises, so that through them you may participate in the divine nature...” 2 Peter 1:4-5*

The multitude of promises contained in the Word of God ought to encourage us to believe like Abraham, against all hope.

## All God's Promises

2 Corinthians 1:20

“For all the promises of God in him are yes, and in him Amen, unto the glory of God by us.”

## God is not a Man!

Numbers 23:19

“God is not a man, that he should lie; neither the son of man, that he should repent: has he said, and shall he not do it? or has he spoken, and shall he not make it good?”

## God Guarantees It

### 1 - Immutability of God...

*He does not change*

### 2 - Promises of God...

*He does not lie*

## Hebrews 6:17-19

“Wherein God, willing more abundantly to show unto the heirs of promise the immutability of his counsel, confirmed it by an oath: That by two immutable things, in which it was impossible for God to lie,

“We might have a strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the hope set before us: Which hope we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and steadfast.

## Only Three Things Hinder

1. Sin – if I regard sin he will not hear
2. Selfishness – consume it on lusts
3. Suspicion – slow of heart to believe

“You ask, and receive not, because you ask amiss, that you may consume it upon your lusts.” - James 4:3

“He could do no mighty miracle except to lay his hands on a few sick folk, because of their unbelief.” – Mark 6:5

## Before the Throne of God

*As a child of God I inherit all the promises of God in Christ. I am a joint heir with him.*

1. I am a child of God
2. I am right with God
3. I believe God's promises

*Abraham believed God, hoped against all hope, staggered not at the promise, ignored the reality of his old body, and was fully persuaded God was able to perform what he promised.*

## God Never Says No

*God never says "NO" to his own promises. He cannot contradict himself.*

1. YES!
2. WAIT!
3. Here's Something BETTER

*Job 13:15 – Though he slay me...*

*Habakkuk 3:17 – Though the fig tree...*

## Conclusion: Application

**God is faithful. He longs to bless. He delights to answer prayer. He is the same yesterday, today, and forever.**
