

I. Meaning of “Fullness”


- 1. It's About Weakness** (Jacob, Moses)
- 2. It's About God's Power** (Acts 1:8)
- 3. It's About Transformation** (Rom12:1-2)

If you don't want to change then don't ask for the fullness. If you're content with the way things are, don't ask!

II. How Receive Fullness

1. **Thirst & Hunger** (Isaiah 55:1-3 & Mt 5:6)
2. **Ask, keep asking** (Luke 11:13)
3. **Seek, knock, pursue** (Acts 1:4) wait!
4. **Surrender, give up, over** (Rom 12:1-2)
