And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him.

1. Faith is being sure of what we hope for, and certain of what we do not see.

2. Faith is outrageous trust in God.

3. Faith means believing in advance what will only make sense in reverse.

- 1. Faith is an every day event.*
